The European Regional Master's Programme in Democracy and Human Rights (ERMA) is a double degree programme established in 2000/2001 by University of Sarajevo and the University of Bologna, co-financed by the European Commission and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Italy. The programme promotes the creation of a young generation of perspective officials for state management, inter-governmental and non-governmental organizations, universities and think-tanks in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, FYR of Macedonia, Kosovo, Montenegro and Serbia, as well as in the countries belonging to the EU, the rest of Europe, and worldwide. ERMA is a one year interdisciplinary programme consisting of three terms that combine academic studies with field research and working experience.

CALENDAR



1ST TERM

NOVEMBER - JUNE

During the first term, students follow courses in Sarajevo taught by professors from participating university members within the "International Network Europe and Balkans" and are supervised by three academic tutors.

2ND TERM

JUNE - JULY

In the second term, students participate in seven-week internships at selected IGOs, NGOs, think-tanks and research institutes working in the field of human rights and democracy across South East Europe, while conducting their field research for the purposes of their Master`s Theses.

3RD TERM

SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER

During the third term, students focus on finalizing their Master`s Theses in Italy, accommodated at the CEUB "University Residential Center of Bertinoro" and attend short seminars and lectures within the yearly international summer school organized by the Institute for Central-Eastern and Balkan Europe (IECOB).

ERMA is open to candidates who hold a university degree (min 240 ECTS) in disciplines relevant to human rights, law, politics, economics, sociology, journalism, psychology and humanities from an accredited university.

selected candidates are awarded study grants covering living and travel expenses as well as health insurance. Twenty five places are reserved for citizens of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, FYR of Macedonia, Kosovo, Montenegro and Serbia. Five places are reserved for citizens of the European Union, countries of the Caucasus (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia) and Russian Federation. Three places are reserved for self-funding students from other countries.
